## Call for Candidates for an Athletes` Commission Representative

EFDF calls for candidates for an Athletes' Commission Representative for those disciplines not represented by an EFDF Extraordinary Member (EUF, EDGF)

## Application process:

Every National Member Federation of EFDF suggests up to one candidate for those disciplines not represented by an EFDF Extraordinary Member; one of the suggested candidates will be chosen by the EFDF Board of Directors for 2 years into the Athletes`Commission.

The National Member Federations of the EFDF are asked to send an email to <a href="mailto:elections@efdf.org">efdf.org</a> preferably before the 15 July 2023, with:

- Full Name, Address and E-Mail-Address of the suggested representative,
- Date of birth of the representative,
- Confirmation that the suggested person has never received any sanction in relation to the World Anti-Doping Code,
- Confirmation that the suggested person is participating at international level or has done so within the previous four years,
- Representing discipline of the candidate.

## Members of the Athletes` Commission are expected to:

- Participate at Commissions` meetings, ~1-3 times per year via videoconferencing,
- React to email correspondence within five (5) business days,
- Read all correspondence on the Commissions' mailing list.

The Athletes` Commission has the following tasks (<a href="https://www.efdf.org/wp-content/uploads/2023/04/Athletes Commission Regulation.pdf">https://www.efdf.org/wp-content/uploads/2023/04/Athletes Commission Regulation.pdf</a>):

- Represent the views and opinions of the athletes and ensure their voice is heard within the EFDF as the umbrella organisation of Flying Disc Sports in Europe;
- Inform athletes about the EFDF's activities (i.e. educational tools, rules and regulations);
- Work with and support the EFDF in its mission to develop and promote the Flying Disc Sports;
- Serve as a non-political group which can offer advice, feedback, and assistance to EFDF on matters and issues of relevance to all Flying Disc Sport athletes;
- Promote high standards of sportsmanship and ethical performance when athletes are competing/participating at the international level:
- Provide recommendations to the EFDF Board on issues of relevance to athletes;
- Give feedback to the EFDF Board on areas of improvement and/ or concerns that require input from athletes;
- Relate directly to and represent athletes competing at the highest level and establish relationships to promote feedback to EFDF on matters concerning elite athletes;
- Act as a promotional tool available for the purposes of promoting Disc Sport to sponsors, the media and the general public;
- Engage actively with initiatives and projects that protect and support clean athletes on and off the field of play;
- Consult with athletes in the evaluation of the rules and regulations of their respective sport and subsequently provide feedback to the EFDF Board.
