INTERACT+:

In April the partners of the INTERACT+ project first time met face to face at the University of Limerick in Ireland. INTERACT+ is a project of TAFISA (The Association For International Sport For All), together with eight partner organizations, funded by the Erasmus+ program of the European Union. EFDF is represented by its Sport for All Advisor Jörg Benner who already was involved for DFV in the first INTERACT project from January 2021 to December 2022. The aim of the projects is that international and national sports organizations positively influence participation rates in physical activity at grassroots level, especially considering disadvantaged target groups. The INTERACT+ project builds on the results already achieved (see <https://interact-sport.com/>) and works on capacity building workshops, train the trainer workshops, a new model for implementing Sport for All offers and an exchange platform for associations. Still this year a capacity building workshop for representatives of national Flying Disc Federations is planned. EFDF will inform.

Athletes Commission:

The EFDF is setting up an Athletes Commission (AC). EDGF has already nominated their representatives and EUF has created a working group tasked setting up an Athletes Commission at EUF and nominating the representatives for the EFDF's AC. EFDF is also sending out a call to all the national federation to nominate candidates for sports not represented by EDGF and EUF.

Multi-Sport Events:

EFDF is working in collaboration with WFDF to include flying-disc sports in Multisport Games. Here is a list of the upcoming multi-sport events with flying-disc:

The future will see EFDF as a permanent partner of Multisport Games.

- A contract was signed between WFDF and EUSA (European University Sport Association) to include Ultimate in the EUSA Games in 2024 in Debrecen. Discussions are still on-going to finalize event details and involvement of EFDF.
- Inclusion of Beach Ultimate might also be a possibility for the EUSA Beach Games in 2023 or 2024.
- European Masters Games by IMGA (International Masters Games Association) in summer 2023 in Finland will propose Disc Golf as a new discipline.
